Access guide to the venue (Morito memorial hall)

From JR Iidabashi station to the venue (about 6 min.)

Please go out from the WEST gate of JR Iidabashi station. (JR: Japan Railway)

(NOTE: If your hotel is Metropolitan, APA Iidabashi Ekimae, or APA Iidabashi Ekiminami, you should go out from the EAST gate.)

Venue

After going out from JR Iidabashi station, please turn RIGHT and go straight forward. After crossing the street, you will walk UP the Kagurazaka street. (It is recommended that you will leave your large luggage at your hotel before coming to the venue.)

After 3-minutes-walk, you will find a red shrine on the left-hand side. Then, turn to the RIGHT to the alley just opposite the shrine.

Note: the alley is too narrow. Do not hesitate to enter the alley. You will find the venue at the end of the alley.

From **NARITA airport** to JR Iidabashi station

Take the [JR Narita Express train](#) to JR Tokyo Station. Transfer to the JR Chuo Line (Rapid, Track No. 1), and take it to Ochanomizu Station. Transfer to the JR Chuo-Sobu Line (Local) and take it to JR Iidabashi Station.

Travel time: about 2 hours.

From **HANEDA airport** to JR Iidabashi station

Take the [Tokyo Monorail](#) to Hamamatsucho Station. Transfer to the JR Yamanote Line (Local) and take it to Akihabara Station. Transfer to the JR Chuo-Sobu Line (Local, Track No. 5 which is located upstairs.) and take it to JR Iidabashi Station.

Travel time: about 45 minutes.

NOTE: If you will arrive at HANEDA on weekend, you can purchase [a discount ticket](#).

From **JR Tokyo station** to JR Iidabashi station

Take the JR Chuo Line (Rapid, Track No. 1) to Ochanomizu Station. Transfer to the JR Chuo-Sobu Line (Local) and take it to JR Iidabashi Station.

Travel time: about 10 minutes.
